Applicants to the Summer Partnership in Law program must be students in good standing at their undergraduate school. Minority students, women, and other students from groups that are under-represented in the legal profession are encouraged to apply. Applicants must have a C+ or better grade in core subjects which have been identified as crucial to law school success. These subjects include, but are not limited to, English (including writing, composition, journalism, etc.), philosophy (especially logic), math (including algebra, calculus, etc.), and “hard” science, computer, or engineering courses.

To apply, please submit the information below with a copy of your transcript and a brief (two pages or less) typed essay describing your reason for wanting to study in a law school program and outlining any experience you might have had with the law or legal issues.
