Tuesday, May 17 at 6:30 p.m.	Professor Knapp’s presentation: “How to Write a Case Note” in the Auditorium. (This is also available on a reserve DVD in the Library.)
Tuesday, May 17 at 7:30 p.m.	Download the competition materials from the <i>Law Review</i> website.
May 22–June 4	During this period, participants may e-mail up to two drafts of their work to their assigned editors. The editors will review the drafts and provide feedback. Your editor will contact you via email on May 18 explaining how to submit drafts.
Tuesday, June 7 at 5:00 p.m.	Write-on Competition <i>papers</i> are due in Student Services* <u>NO LATER</u> than 5:00 p.m. Bluebook <i>quizzes</i> are due <u>VIA EMAIL NO LATER</u> than 5:00 p.m. and <u>MUST BE SENT TO</u> eic.lawreview@wmitchell.edu . NOTES ABOUT DISCUSSING TOPICS: *You may not at any time discuss the case or its legal issues with ANYONE, including but not limited to non-participants, professors, judges, practitioners, reference librarians, circulation librarians, law school graduates, Lexis or Westlaw representatives, or other law students. You may disclose your topic to other participants but once the Competition begins you may not discuss your topic in any form with anyone. You may not interview anyone as part of your research, including authors of any written work you cite or attorneys involved in the case. While collaboration is a vital aspect of serving on Law Review, it is inappropriate at the Competition stage. Your case note and citation quiz is to be completed 100% on your own. ANY DIVERGENCE FROM THESE RULES MAY LEAD TO AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.*
