

Law in Edinburgh and London 2008

TERMS OF ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Tuition and Housing Fees

Registration fee for all participants

- \$150 (one-time, non-refundable)

Edinburgh and London sessions

- Tuition: \$2,400 (\$600/credit)
- Course fee: \$225/course;
\$450/session

The registration fee is a non-refundable administration payment which does not apply toward tuition or housing fees. The course fee is a contribution towards program expenses other than tuition, such as course materials, receptions, and visits. Tuition and fees do not include housing, airfare, or transportation costs. Participants must make their own transportation arrangements.

Those waiting on financial aid for tuition will not be assessed a late fee. Tuition refunds for those who withdraw from the program will be based on how long the participants were enrolled with no refunds for participants who have completed at least 60 percent of the program.

Housing fees

- Edinburgh: \$1,149/session for a single room with a shared toilet and shower or \$1,529/session for a single room with private toilet and shower.
- London: \$1,147/session

Tuition and housing fees for those taking the Edinburgh and London course sessions are due and payable in full U.S. dollars to William Mitchell College of Law by April 18, 2008. Refunds for housing fees will not be given if you cancel after May 2, 2008. If you cancel prior to May 2, 2008 you will be refunded 80 percent of your housing fee.

Accreditation

This program has been approved by the American Bar Association Section of Legal Education and Admissions to the Bar. It meets ABA requirements for foreign summer schools. For participants requiring ABA credits, attendance is mandatory for all classes, visits, and other scheduled activities. Financial Aid

Participants should contact the financial aid officer at their home schools to determine eligibility for financial aid. If you are waiting for financial aid to pay for your tuition, you will not be assessed a late fee.

Grading and Credits

Participants in the Edinburgh and London course sessions requiring ABA credit will be awarded a letter grade on an A-F scale based on a 2-hour written examination for each course. Acceptance of any credit or grade for any course taken in the program is subject to determination by the participant's home school. It is unlikely that participation in a foreign summer program may be used to accelerate graduation. Students interested in acceleration should consult their home schools to review this issue in light of ABA Standard 304, Interpretation 304-4.

Cancellation or Changes in the Program

Registrants will be notified in writing if the Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 summer abroad program is cancelled and will be refunded fees paid, including housing. If particular courses are cancelled, registrants will be refunded fees or may elect to take another course in the program. The liability of participating law schools shall be limited to a refund of fees paid on any cancellation of the program or particular courses. The program is subject to change.

International Transportation

Participants are responsible for arranging their own international transportation to and from London and/or Edinburgh.

Liability Schedules for Tuition and Housing Fees

Tuition and housing fees for Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 are due and payable in full on April 18, 2008. A late payment charge of .67% per month (8% per annum) will be applied to any balance remaining unpaid after April 18, 2008.

Tuition: If a participant withdraws from the Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 course sessions or reduces credit load, the amount of tuition refunded will be based on the percentage of the enrollment period completed, except that no refund will be made to participants who complete at least 60% of the enrollment period.

Housing: If you cancel on or prior to May 5, 2008 you will pay 20% of all housing fees. If you cancel after May 5 you will pay 100%.

Other Provisions

Amounts stated in this agreement pertain to the Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 summer abroad program only. Transcripts will not be issued to participants who are indebted to William Mitchell College of Law. The college will add to a student's indebtedness any attorney fees or other costs and charges incurred by the college in collecting past-due obligations.

Release

The Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 summer abroad program is offered solely as a convenience for law students. Participation is entirely voluntary. It is up to law students who choose to participate to make their own travel arrangements to, from, and while in London and/or Edinburgh. Neither William Mitchell College of Law nor other participating law schools have any responsibility or liability for those arrangements.

For the convenience of participants, housing may be arranged at The Acorn and/or Pollock Halls facilities. Neither William Mitchell nor other participating law schools nor The Acorn/Pollock Halls facilities assume responsibility for supervising the behavior of participants outside the classroom.

Participants are strongly encouraged to make their own insurance and medical arrangements before leaving for Britain. Neither William Mitchell College of Law nor other participating law schools provide insurance coverage or arrange medical care for participants enrolled in the 2008 summer abroad program, nor do they have any liability for acting or failing to act in situations requiring emergency medical care.

Neither William Mitchell College of Law nor any of its trustees, faculty, or staff will be liable for any loss, injury, or damage to persons or property that may be incurred in connection with the events, activities, accommodations, transportation, or other services associated with or incidental to the Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 program. This release includes any loss, injury, or damage that is the result of any activity or passive negligence on the part of the college, its trustees, faculty, or staff. Participating law schools and their trustees, faculty, and staff shall have no liability or responsibility for any additional expense or liability sustained or incurred as a result of any of the aforementioned causes.

Registration Instructions

Admission to Law in Edinburgh and London 2008 is limited and will be on a "first come, first served" basis.

You will NOT be considered registered for the program until your signed registration form and application fee have been received by the college. Applications must be received no later than April 4, 2008.

To be accepted for admission, you must submit:

- **A registration form.** (Print, fill out, sign, and mail to Jennifer Miller at William Mitchell College of Law registration form.)
- **A letter of good standing** from your home school registrar (in a sealed envelope submitted with your registration form or mailed directly from your registrar to Jennifer Miller at William Mitchell).
- **A non-refundable application fee of \$150.** (Make checks payable to William Mitchell College of Law.)
